

How to Buy FLU

A step-by-step guide to purchasing Influenza (FLU) on Pump.fun

1. Get a Solana wallet

Download a Solana-compatible wallet like Phantom or Solflare from the official app store or website — never from a link in a random post. Create a new wallet and securely back up your seed phrase offline. Never share your seed phrase with anyone, including anyone claiming to be from Influenza or Pump.fun support.

2. Fund the wallet with SOL

Buy SOL on an exchange (Coinbase, Kraken, etc.) and withdraw it to your wallet's Solana address, or buy SOL directly inside the wallet app if it supports on-ramping. You'll need a bit extra beyond your intended purchase amount to cover network transaction fees.

3. Go to the official FLU page

Open pump.fun and navigate to Influenza's page using the official link from the Influenza website or verified X account — never search by name alone, since scammers create copycat tokens.

4. Verify the contract address

Before doing anything else, compare the contract address shown on the pump.fun page character-by-character against the address published on the Influenza Transparency page. This single check prevents buying a fake token.

5. Connect your wallet

Click “Connect Wallet” on pump.fun, choose your wallet app, and approve the connection request in the pop-up. Only approve connection requests — never sign a transaction you don't understand.

6. Enter the purchase amount

Type the amount of SOL you want to spend on FLU. The page will show an estimated amount of FLU you'll receive based on the current bonding curve price, which moves as people buy and sell.

7. Confirm the transaction

Review the details in your wallet's pop-up (amount, token, network fee) and approve it. The transaction is final once confirmed on the blockchain — there's no undo.

8. Verify your holdings

Check your wallet or a block explorer like Solscan to confirm the FLU tokens arrived. Save the transaction ID for your records.
